Celebrant:

Celebrant:

As grapes are crushed to make this wine,
so we offer to you all who are crushed by hunger,
homelessness, violence or abuse.

who on the night He was betrayed took bread, gave you thanks, broke it and gave it to His disciples saying

"Take eat, this is my body which is broken for you.

After supper he took the cup, gave you thanks and said to them "Drink, all of you,

this is my blood which is shed for you and the many for the forgiveness of sin.

Do this as often as you drink it in remembrance of me"
